IGCS and the Sustainable Development Goals







What we are doing in 2023:

- Reduced registration fees for low-resource countries
- Gender diverse and balanced faculty to ensure inclusivity and diverse perspectives
- Creating a welcoming and accepting environment for all participants, regardless of sex, gender, nationality, race, color, age, or physical disability

Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns

We recognise the environmental impact that large-scale events like IGCS can have, so sustainable production and consumption are one of our top priorities in organizing the IGCS 2023 Meeting. We are working with our suppliers to ensure maximum positive change.

What we are doing in 2023:

- Utilizing technology to avoid paper usage. Advertising, certificates, program, etc... will only be available in pdf, use of QR codes, mobile app
- Promoting hotels within walking distance to delegates to minimize transportation resources and reduce environmental impact
- Minimizing waste generation by controlling the number of attendees to avoid waste and unnecessary leftovers
- Encouraging the use of water fountains instead of single-use plastic

Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts

We are committed to reducing our environmental footprint and mitigating the impact of our event on climate change.

What we are doing in 2023:

- By conducting most of the congress organization meetings virtually, we are actively contributing to reduce the carbon footprint associated with travel
- Choosing Seoul as the conference city due to its communications to reducing the carbon footprint of travel
- The on-demand sessions access reduces the impact of

participant travel

- Utilizing daylight to illuminate activities and program sessions helps reduce energy generation for artificial lighting
- Selecting COEX as a sustainable venue due to renewable energy initiatives and promoting sustainable practices (click <u>here</u> to see COEX's initiatives)
